Legal Trouble

The Danish Association of Feminists has filed for a preliminary injunction against D.A.D, claiming that the famous logo Molly infringes on its members copyright.

A large number of the authors of the 70's book "Woman Know Your Body" recently noticed a striking similarity between the artistic renditions of the uterus used in the many editions of the book, to the graphic logo modified and used by D.A.D to depict the cow-head.

D.A.D is currently seeking legal counsel trying to assess what has to be done and whether this must go to court or some kind of agreement can be made. The various artists involved in the design of the logo over the years have been adviced not to make any public statements for now.

Here on the website, we feel that the fans themselves should have the opportunity of comparing whether the book authors are right in claiming that the similarities can not be a coincidence, or not.
